## Summary of Proposed Regulation 802 KAR 3:040. Additional Award Requests.

- Creates a new regulation establishing the procedure and criteria for processing and awarding additional award requests filed after the Board grants an award to a claimant in their initial claim related to the same crime.
- After filing the initial claim, claimants often incur additional eligible expenses not included in the previous claim or previously incurred expenses for which they did not yet have adequate documentation at the time they filed the original claim.
- The regulation makes clear that, when filing for an additional award, a claimant does not have to provide any documentation which was previously submitted with the initial claim.
- The regulation clarifies that the statutory monetary award maximum of \$50,000 applies to the total of all related claims arising out of a single crime, and not to each individual award request.
