I. JULY MONTHLY REPORT

During the month of July 2026, the Board of Claims received **120** negligence claims filed against the Commonwealth. The Board rendered **37** decisions in claims *under \$2,500.00* in July. Of those, **11** were dismissed and **26** were awarded for a total amount of **\$18,497.85** in awards.

At its July meeting, the Board affirmed **3** claim upon Full Board Review, dismissed **14** claims via Recommended Orders, Agreed Orders of Dismissal, and *sua sponte* dismissals; and awarded **4** claims through Agreed Orders of Dismissal, awarding an additional amount of **\$8,267.31**. With the claims under \$2,500.00, and those decided at the June Meeting, the Board decided **58** claims, dismissing a total of **28** claims, awarding a total of **30** claims for a total amount awarded of **\$26,765.16**.
