#### I. JANUARY MONTHLY REPORT

During the month of January, the Board of Claims received 94 negligence claims filed against the Commonwealth.

The Board rendered **56** decisions in claims *under \$2,500.00* in January 2025. Of those, **38** were dismissed and **18** were awarded for a total amount awarded of **\$10,739.08**.

At its January meeting, the Board affirmed **4** claims upon Full Board Review, remanded **2** claims from the docket, dismissed **20** claims via Recommended Orders, Motions, or *sua sponte* dismissals, and awarded **6** claims through Recommended Orders, Agreed Orders of Dismissal, and entries of Final Orders, awarding an additional **\$19,182.50**. With the claims under \$2,500.00, and those decided at the January Meeting, the Board decided **86** claims, dismissing a total of **62** claims, and awarding a total of **24** claims for a total amount awarded of **\$29,921.58**.
