Investigator Jackie Lynch decided 48 claims under \$1,000.00 in December, 2015. Jackie reports that 26 of these claims were denied and 22 were awarded, for a total amount awarded of \$8,414.61.

At its Board meeting on December 17, 2015, the Board dismissed 10 claims and awarded seven (7) claims totaling \$26,337.39. Together with the claims investigated in-house, the Board dismissed a total of 36 claims and awarded a total of 33 claims for a total amount awarded of \$34,752.00 in December, 2015.

Full Board Review

On June 19, 2015, Claimant was fighting on the yard with another inmate when he was taken directly to the Special Management Unit or Segregation. His property was packed by two officers which is what policy allows when an inmate has to be taken to Segregation because he had been fighting. When they turned on the TV in Receiving and Discharge it did not work. This was noted on the Claimant's property sheet. Staff did take precautions with the TV and wrapped it in a blanket before storing it.

Claimant has turned this around to say that staff let other inmates pack his property, but Respondent stated this is not permitted and it did not happen in this case. Claimant provided a piece of paper called a "Witness Statement Form" in which an inmate stated "Prior to Inmate Watts packing Inmate Hopper 's property, Inmate Hopper T.V. was working and functional." Respondent said they do not allow inmates to assist them in packing inmate property. Respondent says Claimant has provided no proof his TV was damaged by staff. He had his television with his property before he was taken to segregation.
