June 19, 2023 Meeting

MINUTES

The meeting, conducted via Zoom, was called to order at approximately 10:00 am., and the following business was conducted in Board of Claims matters.

In attendance were Board members Samuel Wright, Dale Sights, and Kathryn Thomas. Chairman Wright called the meeting to order.

A quorum existed and business was conducted. Also in attendance were Executive Director John Hardesty, Staff Attorney Shelby Bevins-Sullivan, Clerk Katie Dean, Hearing Officers Eden Davis Stephens and Shawn D. Chapman, Attorney Chadler Hardin for Claimant Tradewater Organics, LLC, Attorneys Nathan Goens and Robert Chaney for Respondent Department of Corrections, and Attorney Johann Herkotz for Respondent University of Kentucky.

After Executive Director Hardesty delivered the monthly report for the Board of Claims for May 2023, the May Minutes were approved. Member Dale Sights moved to approve the May 2023 Minutes with Chairman Wright seconding. Having all in favor, the Motion carried.
