COMMONWEALTH OF KENTUCKY Claims Commission Minutes March 27, 2018

The Kentucky Claims Commission received 86 negligence claims filed against the Commonwealth during the month of February, 2018. Angela reports that 37 of these claims were set up for under \$2,500.00.

Investigators Angela Robertson and Raymond Shields decided 31 claims under \$2,500.00 in February, 2018. Angela reports that 22 of these claims were dismissed and nine (9) were awarded, for a total amount awarded of **\$3,976.03**.

At its meeting on February 27, 2018, the Kentucky Claims Commission dismissed 11 negligence claims and awarded none. Together with the claims investigated in-house, the Claims Commission dismissed a total of 33 negligence claims and awarded a total of nine (9) negligence claims for a total amount awarded of **\$3,976.03** in February, 2018.
