## **May 20, 2024 Meeting**

#### **MINUTES**

The meeting, conducted via Zoom, was called to order at approximately 2:14 pm., and the following business was conducted in Board of Claims matters.

In attendance were Board members Samuel Wright, Kathryn Thomas, and Dale Sights. Chairman Wright called the meeting to order.

A quorum existed and business was conducted. Also in attendance were: Executive Director John Hardesty, Staff Attorneys Shelby Bevins-Sullivan and Linda Horsman, Clerk Katie Dean, Hearing Officer Charles Miller, Attorney Mark Eppley for Claimant Savannah Jackson, Attorney Amy Robertson for Respondent Cabinet of Health and Family Services, and Claimant Erin Bowman.

After Director Hardesty delivered the monthly report for the Board of Claims for April 2024, the April 2024 Minutes were approved. Member Kathryn Thomas moved to approve the April 2024 Minutes with Member Dale Sights seconding. Having all in favor, the Motion carried.

After approval of the prior meeting's Minutes, the following cases were taken up for consideration:

**BC-24-0134**: Erin Bowman v. Transportation Cabinet, Dept. of Highways (KYTC) 1st: Kathryn Thomas 2nd: Dale Sights. Having all in favor, the Motion carried.

• The Board vacated its prior decision, awarding the Claimant \$295.08 in damages.

**BC-23-0755**: <u>Jessica Robinson v. Cabinet of Health and Family Services, Western State Hospital</u> 1st: Kathryn Thomas 2nd: Dale Sights. Having all in favor, the Motion carried.

• The Board sustained the Respondent's Motion to Dismiss, dismissing the claim.
