COMMONWEALTH OF KENTUCKY Claims Commission **Minutes**

November 28, 2017

The Kentucky Claims Commission received 57 negligence claims filed against the Commonwealth during the month of October, 2017. Sasha Petrey reports that 30 claims were set up and 19 claims were returned for lack of jurisdiction.

Investigator Angela Robertson decided 19 claims under \$2,500.00 in October, 2017. Angela reports that 12 of these claims were denied and seven (7) were awarded, for a total amount awarded of \$4,548.72.

At its meeting on October 24, 2017, the Kentucky Claims Commission dismissed ten (10) negligence claims and awarded three (3) consolidated negligence claims totaling \$150,000.00. Together with the claims investigated in-house, the Claims Commission dismissed a total of 22 negligence claims and awarded a total of eight (8) negligence claims for a total amount awarded of \$154,548.72 in October, 2017.
