I. <u>SEPTEMBER MONTHLY REPORT</u>

During the month of September 2024, the Board of Claims received **68** negligence claims filed against the Commonwealth.

The Board rendered **66** decisions in claims *under \$2,500.00* in September 2024. Of those, **23** were dismissed and **43** were awarded for a total amount awarded of **\$22,892.51**.

At its September meeting, the Board affirmed 1 claim upon Full Board Review, placed 1 claim in abeyance, dismissed 14 claims upon motions, recommended orders, or *sua sponte* dismissals, and entered 6 Agreed Orders of Dismissal, awarding an additional \$6,250.00. With the claims under \$2,500.00, and those decided at the August Meeting, the Board decided 87 claims, dismissing a total of 38 claims, and awarding a total of 49 claims for a total amount awarded of \$29,142.51.
