I. AUGUST MONTHLY REPORT

During the month of July 2026, the Board of Claims received **98** negligence claims filed against the Commonwealth. The Board rendered **11** decisions in claims *under \$2,500.00* in August. Of those, **7** were dismissed and **4** were awarded for a total amount of **\$2,824.01** in awards.

At its August meeting, the Board dismissed **1** claim via Agreed Orders of Dismissal; and awarded **8** claims through Agreed Orders of Dismissal, awarding an additional amount of **\$25,982.35**. With the claims under \$2,500.00, and those decided at the August Meeting, the Board decided **23** claims, reprehended **1** claim back to a hearing officer, held **1** claim over to September Agenda, issued **1** Order to Show Cause, dismissing a total of **8** claims, awarding a total of **12** claims for a total amount awarded of **\$28,806.36**.
