May 2021 Monthly Report:

During the month of May, 2021, the Board of Claims received **54** negligence claims filed against the Commonwealth.

The Board rendered **43** decisions in claims *under* \$2,500.00 in May, 2021. Of those, **20** were dismissed and **23** were awarded for a total amount awarded of **\$11,743.38**.

At its May, 2021, meeting, the Board awarded **1** additional negligence claims in the total award amount of **\$2,528.73** and dismissed **5** other claims. Together with the claims under \$2,500.00, the Board decided **49** claims altogether, while dismissing a total of **25** negligence claims and awarding a total of **24** negligence claims for a total amount awarded of **\$14,272.11** during the month.
