## NOTICE OF UPCOMING TRAINING

Purpose: Staff with the Kentucky Crime Victims Compensation Board will be conducting a training on the Crime Victims Compensation (CVC) and Sexual Assault Examination (SAE) programs. Topics of discussion will include, but not necessarily be limited to: (1) claim and Claimant eligibility, (2) compensable expenses, (3) caps on award amounts, (4) reasons behind claim reductions or dismissals, (5) the CVC claims process itself, (6) the availability of emergency assistance, and (7) CVC appeal rights. Trainings last approximately two (2) to two and one-half (2.5) hours.
