March 28, 2025 Special Meeting

MINUTES

Board Chair Parsons called the meeting to order at 1:00 PM and conducted roll call.

The following attended the meeting in person: Board Chair Parsons, Executive Director Hardesty, Staff Attorneys Bevins-Sullivan and Horsman, Executive Staff Advisor Shields, and Restitution/Collections Officer Barrie. Member Roberts attended the meeting virtually.

Executive Director Hardesty advised that staff with the Legislative Review Commission reviewed the proposed administrative regulations that were filed in response to the new requirements set forth by SB 319 and had made some changes. The changes were mostly stylistic and grammatical in nature. There are no concerns among CVC staff nor Cabinet leadership regarding the proposed changes. Executive Director Hardesty and Staff Attorney Bevins-Sullivan outlined and discussed the proposed changes to each proposed administrative regulation.
