November 26, 2024 Special Meeting

MINUTES

Board Chair Parsons called the meeting to order at 1:06 PM and conducted roll call.

The following attended the meeting in person: Board Chair Parsons, Member Leenerts, Executive Director Hardesty, Staff Attorneys Bevins-Sullivan and Horsman, and Executive Staff Advisor Shields. Member Roberts attended virtually via Microsoft Teams.

Executive Director Hardesty reminded the Board that Senate Bill 319 passed during the 2024 legislative session, which substantially expanded the program. This expansion required new regulations and alterations to claim forms, published materials, etc. When any form is required to be used, they must be incorporated by reference into an agency's administrative regulations.

The Board discussed the new administrative regulations and outlined changes that they wanted to see made before voting on their approval. The goal is for the Board to review and approve the amended administrative regulations at its upcoming meeting on December 10, 2024.

Board Chair Parsons motioned to adjourn the meeting at 1:45 PM. Member Leenerts seconded the motion. Having all in favor, the motion carried. The November 26, 2024 special meeting of the Crime Victims Compensation Board was officially adjourned at 1:45 PM.
