I. JUNE MONTHLY REPORT

During the month of June 2026, the Board of Claims received **116** negligence claims filed against the Commonwealth. The Board rendered **66** decisions in claims *under \$2,500.00* in June. Of those, **37** were dismissed and **29** were awarded for a total amount of **\$20,746.54** in awards.

At its June meeting, the Board affirmed **2** claim upon Full Board Review, dismissed **7** claims via Recommended Orders, Agreed Orders of Dismissal, and *sua sponte* dismissals; and awarded **5** claims through Agreed Orders of Dismissal, awarding an additional amount of **\$15,546.31**. With the claims under \$2,500.00, and those decided at the June Meeting, the Board decided **81** claims, dismissing a total of **46** claims, awarding a total of **34** claims for a total amount awarded of **\$34,982.97**.
