**I. FEBRUARY MONTHLY REPORT**

During the month of February 2026, the Board of Claims received **117** negligence claims filed against the Commonwealth. The Board rendered **50** decisions in claims *under \$2,500.00* in February. Of those, **28** were dismissed and **22** were awarded for a total amount of **\$13,089.64** in awards.

At its February meeting, the Board denied **1** claim due to be untimely and affirmed **1** claim upon Full Board Review; dismissed **5** claims via Recommended Orders and *sua sponte* dismissals; remanded **1** claim to the assigned hearing officer; and awarded **8** claims through Agreed Orders of Dismissal and entries of Final Orders, awarding an additional amount of **\$24,537.43**. With the claims under \$2,500.00, and those decided at the February Meeting, the Board decided **65** claims, dismissing a total of **35** claims, and awarding a total of **30** claims for a total amount awarded of **\$37,627.07**.
