**I. APRIL MONTHLY REPORT**

During the month of April 2026, the Board of Claims received **103** negligence claims filed against the Commonwealth. The Board rendered **58** decisions in claims *under \$2,500.00* in April. Of those, **32** were dismissed and **26** were awarded for a total amount of **\$15,982.97** in awards.

At its April meeting, the Board affirmed **1** claim upon Full Board Review, dismissed **19** claims via Recommended Orders, Agreed Orders of Dismissal, and *sua sponte* dismissals; and awarded **2** claims through Agreed Orders of Dismissal, awarding an additional amount of **\$19,000.00**. With the claims under \$2,500.00, and those decided at the April Meeting, the Board decided **80** claims, dismissing a total of **52** claims, and awarding a total of **28** claims for a total amount awarded of **\$34,982.97**.
